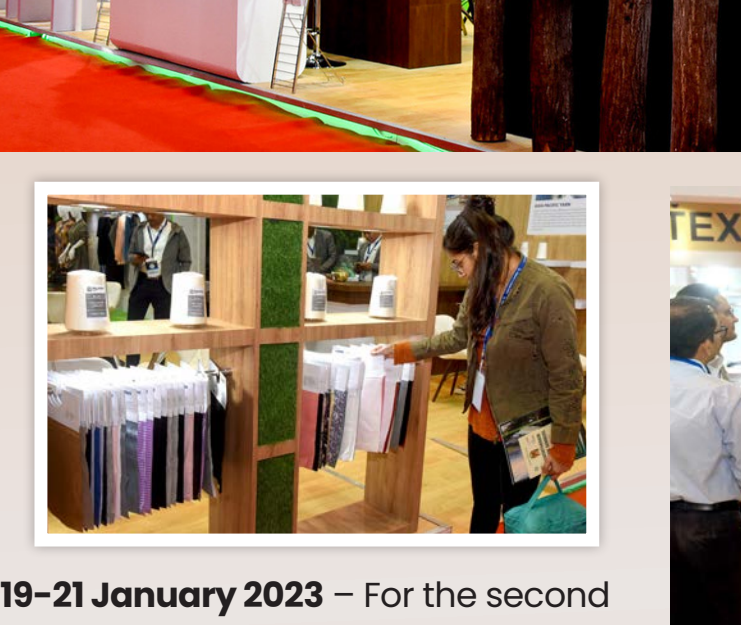
APR Has Received an Award for Being a Role Model in the Indonesian Industry 4.0

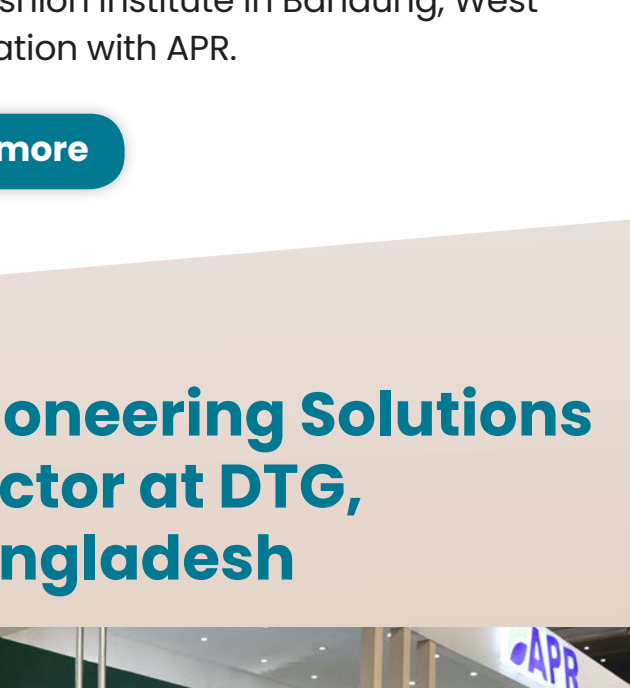

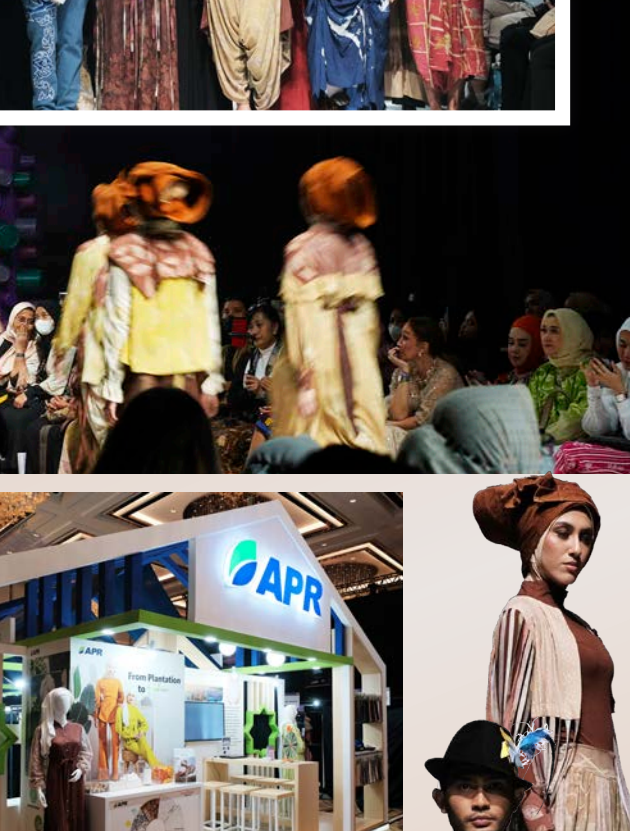

Ecoprint Fashion Week 2023 Shows 75 Designers

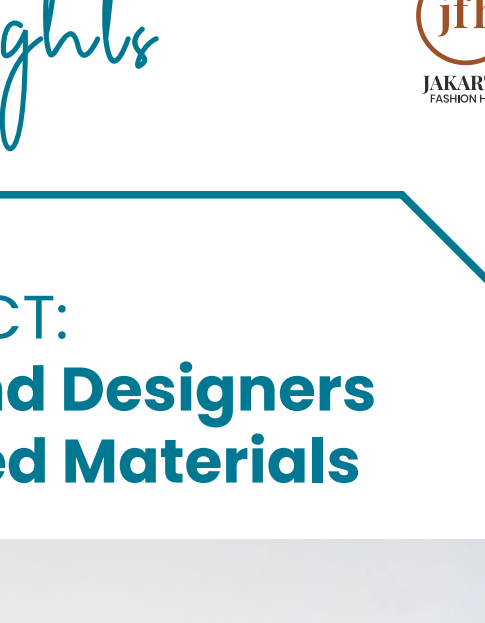

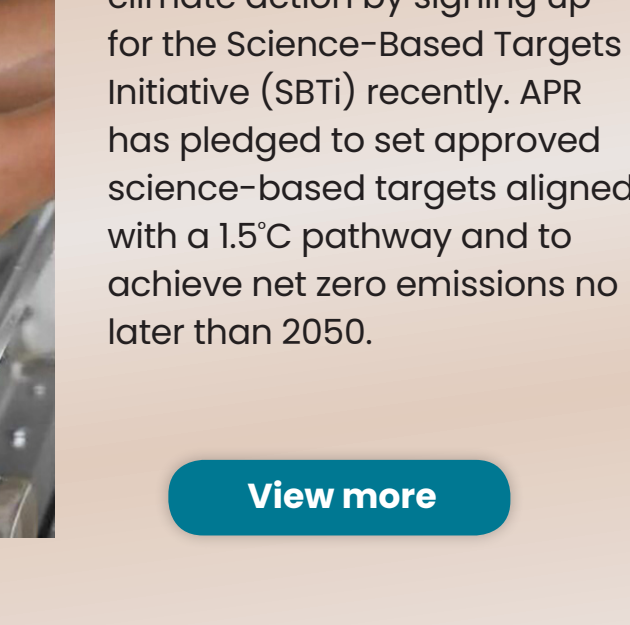
